1) CHALLENGES TO "WE ARE THE WORLD" (:26)

This is Casey Kasem. Last week. "WE ARE THE WORLD" by USA For Africa was at number one for a third consecutive week. There's nothing that can knock that superstar anthem out of the top spot...or is there? Possible challengers are "CRAZY FOR YOU" by Madonna..."RHYTHM OF THE NIGHT" by DeBarge...and "DON'T YOU FORGET ABOUT ME" by Simple Minds. Will "WE ARE THE WORLD" hold on at number one again this week? We'll find out on American Top 40.

2) NEW IN THE TOP FORTY (:20)

Hi this is Casey Kasem. This week, some hot acts are poised to debut in the Top 40 with their latest hits. There's Glenn Frey with "SMUGGLER'S BLUES"...Madonna with "ANGEL"...and the Pointer Sisters with "BABY COME AND GET IT." 3) EXOTICA IN THE TOP FORTY (:26)
