1) HOT MOVIES--HOT SUMMER (:22)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Well it's a hot summer of hot movies and hot movie songs! Two have a good chance of debuting this week on American Top 40. There's the title song from "ST.ELMO'S FIRE" by John Parr. And from "MAD MAX THREE", "WE DON'T NEED ANOTHER HERO" by Tina Turner. We'll be watching them both on the official Billboard chart and listening for them on American Top 40.

2) A FAMILY ON THE MOVE (:20)

This is Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40, the biggest mover was "WHO'S HOLDING DONNA NOW", by the family act DeBarge. Their song leaped from number 31 to 21 on the official Billboard chart. Their last hit, "RHYTHM OF THE NIGHT" went to number 3. How high will the follow-up climb? We'll watch the DeBarge family on the move, on American Top 40.

3) BRYAN ADAMS SUMMER (:20)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40, Bryan Adams debuted with the fourth hit from his album, "RECKLESS." The first three all made the top ten on the official Billboard chart, including his number one song, "HEAVEN." Will Bryan Adams' latest become top ten hit number four? We'll watch him make his move on American Top 40.

4) NEW FROM BILLY BOY (:22)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Y'know Billy Joel has a new album out; a two-record set called "GREATEST HITS, VOLUMES ONE AND TWO." That album includes two new songs, and one of them, "YOU'RE ONLY HUMAN," has a strong chance of debuting this week on American Top 40. Billy will break into the countdown if Billboard gives the word. We'll report that, and all the chart action, on American Top 40.
