1) TEARS FOR FEARS SHOUT IT OUT (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40, the English group, Tear For Fears, made a tremendous leap from number nine to number two with "SHOUT." That's chart power. Will their momentum carry them to number one this week, or will last week's number one, "EVERYTIME YOU GO AWAY" by Paul Young, keep them out of the top spot? We'll report that, and all the official Billboard action, on American Top 40.

2) WHAM'S NUMBER ONE STREAK (:26)

This is Casey Kasem, and Wham are hot! The English duo took their first three Top 40 hits in America all the way to number one. Those same songs also hit number one in Britain. And now here comes Wham's latest single release, "FREEDOM". It's already hit number one in England, and has a strong chance of debuting in this week's countdown. How high will it climb? We'll report that, and all other official Billboard chart action, on American Top 40.

3) DEBUTERS READY FOR COUNTDOWN (:26)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. A lot of new hits are ready to make their debut this week on American Top 40. Among the hottest contenders are "LIFE IN ONE DAY" by Howard Jones..."FREEDOM" by Wham..."POP LIFE" by Prince and the Revolution...and "SMOKIN' IN THE BOYS ROOM"...the first big hit single by the heavy metal band, Motley Crue. If those songs make the right moves on the official Billboard survey, they'll make their first appearance on American Top 40.

4) PHIL COLLINS HOT ON CHART (:23)

I'm Casey Kasem. Who's the hottest man on the charts today? How about Phil Collins? His last three solo hits, "AGAINST ALL ODDS", "ONE MORE NIGHT" and "SUSSUDIO", have all hit number one on the official Billboard survey. His latest, "DON'T LOSE MY NUMBER," debuted in the countdown last week. Is it headed for number one? We'll check out Phil's number, and a lot more, on American Top 40.
