1) YOU OUGHTA SING IN PICTURES (:34)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Well, the holiday film season is beginning to pack American Top 40 with movie songs. Already in the countdown, we have two songs from the new film, "WHITE NIGHTS": the duet "SEPARATE LIVES" by Phil Collins and Marilyn Martin...and "SAY YOU, SAY ME" by Lionel Richie. A good bet to the debuting soon is Paul McCartney's title song from the movie "SPIES LIKE US". And the band Survivor could come into the countdown this week with "BURNING HEART" from Sylvester Stallone's latest battle picture, "ROCKY FOUR". We'll be trackin' all the action of the Official Billboard chart on American Top 40.

2) REVOLVING DOOR (:25)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. For the past six weeks on American Top 40, we've had a new number one every week. Six weeks...six number ones. Last week's number one was Starship's "WE BUILT THIS CITY". Will that be replaced at number one this week by Glenn Frey's "YOU BELONG TO THE CITY"? Or will Starship end the one-week streak by holding on? We'll see what the Official Billboard word is...exclusively on American Top 40.

3) NEW KID ON THE BLOCK (:28)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Some newcomers have a chance to debut on American Top 40 this week. There's the band called Ta Mara & The Seen with their song "EVERYBODY DANCE"...the band called Miami Sound Machine with "CONGA"...and, from Bruce Springsteen's E. Street Band, the Big Man who plays saxophone...Clarence Clemmons...singing a duet with Jackson Browne called "YOU'RE A FRIEND OF MINE". We'll see if the Official Billboard survey puts them into the countdown this week on American Top 40.
