A) Who's Pete? (:25)

I'm Casey Kasem. Among the acts who may debut on American Top 40 this week is a rock legend -- a man who used to be famous for smashing his guitar at the end of every concert -- the great Pete Townshend, from the band, The Who. Pete's last solo appearance in the Top 40 was back in 1980 with "LET MY LOVE OPEN THE DOOR." Will he debut this week with his latest called "FACE THE FACE"? The official Billboard chart will give us the answer on American Top 40.

B) Who's on First? (:27)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. One of the hottest new acts of the past year -- the English duo who "Woke Us Up Before We Go-Go'd" and overheard a "Careless Whisper," are back with their newest single. This new one from Wham is "I'M YOUR MAN." Will Wham's George Michael and Andrew Ridgley make the countdown this week? We'll be checking the official Billboard action on American Top 40.
