1) KING OF THE HILL (:19)

This is Dave Roberts for Casey Kasem. The smash "ROCK ME AMADEUS" has been at number one for two weeks now. But pushing hard, we've got "R.O.C.K. IN THE U.S.A.," by John Cougar Mellencamp at number two and "KISS" by Prince & the Revolution at number three. Who'll have the most popular song in the land this week? We'll find out on American Top 40.

2) THE AUSTRIAN INVASION? (:24)

This is Dave Roberts for Casey Kasem. In the history of the charts, we've had only four acts from Austria. One in the '50's--one in the '60's--Then no acts from Austria for over 25 years. But now the official Billboard survey puts two Austrian acts in the countdown at the same time:--The band Opus with "LIVE IS LIFE"--and Falco with his smash "ROCK ME AMADEUS." We'll hear it all on American Top 40.

3) LITTLE RICHARD WOP BOPS AGAIN (:22)

This is Dave Roberts for Casey Kasem. This week marks the return of a rock legend who last hit the Top 40 28 years ago! Little Richard was last in the Top 40 in 1958 with "OOH! MY SOUL." And now he's getting ready to come back in with "GREAT GOSH A'MIGHTY." Will the official Billboard survey smile on Little Richard this week? We'll find out on American Top 40.
