1) BALLAD TIME AT BILLBOARD (:29)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. For three weeks now, the number one song has been a ballad: "ON MY OWN" by Patti LaBelle and Michael McDonald. And the three songs with the best chance of taking over the top spot are also ballads: "THERE'LL BE SAD SONGS" by Billy Ocean--"HOLDING BACK THE YEARS" by the band Simply Red--and "NO ONE IS TO BLAME" by Howard Jones. Which one of those sweetly-sung songs will slip into the supreme spot in the survey? We'll find out--on American Top 40.

2) ANYTIME YOU'RE READY, C.B. (:30)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Well, we're into the season where movies make the record chart. In last week's countdown, we had eight songs from movie soundtracks. And three of them have already made the top ten: El DeBarge's "WHO'S JOHNNY"--Madonna's "LIVE TO TELL"--and OMD's "IF YOU LEAVE." Three other movie songs with a top ten potential are Kenny Loggin's "DANGER ZONE"--Rod Stewart's "LOVE TOUCH"--and Peter Cetera's "GLORY OF LOVE." So this week, we'll be munching popcorn as we check on American Top 40.

3) MADONNA'S TRUE BLUE HIT (:22)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. This week, according to the official Billboard survey, we may see one of pop's most sizzling superstars leap into the countdown with the second single from her new album, "True Blue." The first went all the way to number one--"LIVE TO TELL." The latest from Madonna is "PAPA DON'T PREACH." And if she's been practicing her chart moves, we'll be hearing from her on American Top 40.

4) AND FROM THE FOLKS WHO BROUGHT YOU DURAN DURAN... (:21)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Among the new songs that may debut in the top 40 this week is a song from the second member of Duran Duran to record solo. John Taylor came first; now Andy Taylor's hoping to hit the Top 40 with "TAKE IT EASY," from the movie "American Anthem." Will Andy take "TAKE IT EASY" into the countdown? We'll find out on American Top 40.
