

We'll follow the official Billboard action this week on American Top 40.

2) MADONNA (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. One of the hottest stars of the 80's--Madonna--has now had three number ones: "LIKE A VIRGIN"..."CRAZY FOR YOU"... and "LIVE TO TELL." Three quite different songs. Last week, Madonna's latest single "PAPA DON'T PREACH " debuted in the countdown--and it's different. Different enough to make number one? Nobody knows yet--but we'll be trackin' the official Billbaord action on American Top 40.

3) THE KNOWN & THE UNKNOWN (:28)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Some familiar names are in good chart positions to possibly enter the Top 40 this week: There's Journey with "SUZANNE"... Michael McDonald with "SWEET FREEDOM"...and Wham, back together with a hit from their farewell album, a song called "THE EDGE OF HEAVEN." But those established acts will have to beat out some newcomers, like the Timex Social Club with "RUMORS" and Gavin Christopher with "ONE STEP CLOSER TO YOU." We'll see what happens this week- on American Top 40.
