Hi, this is Charlie Van Dyke for Casey Kasem. Two months ago, Patti LaBelle was at Number One with "ON MY OWN"; now she's about to debut in the Forty with "OH PEOPLE." Six weeks ago, the English band Simply Red were at Number One with "HOLDING BACK THE YEARS." Their follow-up, "MONEY'S TOO TIGHT TO MENTION", could also debut in the Forty this week. How tough is it to follow up a Number One song? We'll be looking for the answer--on American Top 40.

863-8B Top Gun Fires Again (:22)

Hi, this is Charlie Van Dyke for Casey Kasem. The hottest movie of the summer has been "Top Gun." The soundtrack album hit Number One--and has sent two songs into the Top 40: "DANGER ZONE" by Kenny Loggins and "TAKE MY BREATH AWAY" by Berlin. And now here comes a third "Top Gun" hit "HEAVEN IN YOUR EYES" by Loverboy. If it goes full throttle it could be in the countdown this week--on American Top 40.

863-8C Sermon at the Top (:23)

Hi, this is Charlie Van Dyke for Casey Kasem. Last week, Madonna hit Number One with "PAPA DON'T PREACH."
