



#### 1) JANET THINKS (:26)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. In last week's countdown, Janet Jackson hit number one with "WHEN I THINK OF YOU." But she's probably also thinking about the artists at number two, three four, and five, because they climbed with her last week; Glass Tiger, with "DON'T FORGET ME"— Stacey Q., with "TWO OF HEARTS" Genesis, with "THROWING IT ALL AWAY"—and Tina Turner with "TYPICAL MALE." How will they all land on the official Billboard survey this week? We'll find out on American Top 40!

#### 2) JUMPIN' JACK FRANKLIN (:22)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, the queen of soul rolled a stone into the countdown. Aretha Franklin debuted with a remake of the Rolling Stones' classic, "JUMPIN' JACK FIASH." It's produced by and features the guitar of Keith Richards. The original hit number three. How high will lady soul roll it? I have no idea. But it's fun watching it happen when we do the countdown on American Top 40.

#### 3) BON JOVI BUSTS IN (:20)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. The highest debuting song in last week's countdown was by a band from Bruce Springsteen's home turf. From the Garden state, New Jersey, the band called Bon Jovi debuted at number 29 with the hard rockin' "YOU GIVE LOVE A BAD NAME." Will it give Bon Jovi a big hit? We'll check their moves this week-on American Top 40.

#### 4) MORE FUN WITH WANG CHUNG (:18)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. One of the fastest-climbing records on Billboard's Hot 100 last week was by the English band with the Chinese name—Wang Chung. They sing "EVERYBODY HAVE FUN TONIGHT." And, at the rate they're climbing, they'll be having fun in the Top 40 soon. We'll be on the watch for Wang Chung--on American Top 40.
