- 1) THIS BOSTON BATS 1,000 (:22)
Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, the band Boston had the number one album in the land with "Third Stage." From that album comes the number one song, "AMANDA," now in its second week at number one. But knocking at the door are the Human League at number two with "HUMAN"...and Madonna climbing to number three with "TRUE BLUE." Who'll be at number one this week? We'll find out, the fun way, on American Top 40.
- 2) THE SQUARE OF THE HIP-POTENUSE... (:18)
Hi, this is Casey Kasem. A couple of months back, Huey Lewis and the News hit number one with "STUCK WITH YOU." Now, they're approaching the top ten with their follow-up, "HIP TO BE SQUARE." So are Huey and the boys hip enough to square off at the number one spot? We'll be tracking their action on the official Billboard survey, on American Top 40.
- 3) WHO'S IN CONTROL? MS. JACKSON, THAT'S WHO (:22)
Hi, this is Casey Kasem. One of the year's biggest success stories has been Janet Jackson. Her debut album, "Control," went to number one and has given her three big hits: "WHAT HAVE YOU DONE FOR ME LATELY"... "NASTY"...and, the recent number one song, "WHEN I THINK OF YOU." Her fourth single from the "Control" album is at number 41 on Billboard's Hot Hundred chart. And I'll be surprised if Janet doesn't enter the countdown this week, on American Top 40.
- 4) BROOOOCE! (:24)
Hi, this is Casey Kasem. The 'word' in record stores across the land the past couple of weeks has been "Springsteen." That's the title of the new forty song live album by the Boss. The first single from it is Bruce Springsteen's version of the 1970 number one song by Edwin Starr: "WAR." And it's probably going to land on the official Billboard chart this week. We'll be on the Bruce watch, on American Top 40.
