1) BY THE LIGHT OF THE MOON (:20)

Hi, this is Charlie Van Dyke for Casey Kasem. And here comes the howl of the wolves...in spanish they're called "Los Lobos" -- a Mexican-American band from East Los Angeles. They're closing in on the countdown with "LA BAMBA" -- their remake of the 1950's rock classic by the first Mexican-American rock star, Richie Valens. Los Lobos are stalking the survey...on American Top 40.

2) WHO IS THAT GIRL? (:22)

Hi, I'm Charlie Van Dyke for Casey Kasem. Coming off five top hits from her album "True Blue" -- superstar Madonna is not letting up. This summer, she's starring in a new movie coming out -- "Who's That Girl", and the title song from that movie debuted last week on Billboard's Hot 100 at Number 43. That's Madonna -- looking like she owns the chart -- and we'll be looking for her to debut once again -- on American Top 40.

3) GLORIA'S GONNA GET YA (:18)

Hi, this is Charlie Van Dyke for Casey Kasem. In the last year, the Miami Sound Machine, featuring singer Gloria Estefan exploded on the charts. And just last week, they've led a conga line from #20 to #12 with their latest hit -- "RHYTHM IS GONNA GET YOU". Gloria Estefan and Miami Sound Machine have us dancin' doin' the countdown -- on American Top 40.

4) NUMBER ONE WITH A HEARTBEAT (:17)

Hi, this is Charlie Van Dyke for Casey Kasem. Last week, Heart hit #1 with "ALONE". But comin' up fast, right behind 'em, was Bob Seger with "SHAKEDOWN". Do Heart pulse and palpitate on top again this week -- or is Bob Seger a Heart stopper? We'll check up on all the Official Billboard Chart action -- on American Top 40.
