1) WHITNEY'S STEPPIN' UP (:22)

Hi, this is Charlie Van Dyke for Casey Kasem on American Top 40. Last week, Whitney Houston really stepped into the realm of Pop Chart Royalty. She scored her 6th number one chart single in a row--the hit "SO EMOTIONAL"--putting her name along side the Beatles and the Bee Gees as the only acts ever to do that. 24 year-old Whitney Houston rewritin' chart history--on American Top 40.

2) NEW AND OLD SUPERSTARS (:24)

Hi, this is Charlie Van Dyke for Casey Kasem on American Top 40. And we've got some big names, new and old, fightin' it out for the Top Spot in the land. Last week, climbing to #1 was Whitney Houston with, "SO EMOTIONAL." But right below, jumping to #2 was George Harrison with his first hit in 6 years--"GOT MY MIND SET ON YOU." 3) CHART DE JAVU (:25)

The hottest soundtrack album on the Charts--The #1 Soundtrack from the movie, "DIRTY DANCING"--has already sent two big hits into the countdown--"HUNGRY EYES" by Eric Carmen, and the recent #1 song, "THE TIME OF MY LIFE" by Bill Medley and Jennifer Warnes. And now here comes another: "SHE'S LIKE THE WIND" by "DIRTY DANCING" star Patrick Swayze, with Wendy Frazer. With their chart moves, we could have three Dirty Dancin' ditties --on American Top 40.

5) YOU CAN GO HOME AGAIN (:19)

This is Charlie Van Dyke for Casey Kasem on American Top 40. One of Hollywood's hottest stars--in movies like "SUSPECT" and "MOONSTRUCK"--is coming back home to where she started--the Pop Chart. Cher is looking countdown-bound with a new hit song, "I FOUND SOMEONE." Cher could debut this week--as the beat goes on--on American Top 40.
