3. ROCKERS RETURN (:26)

Hi this is Casey Kasem and the rockers have returned, climbing up the Official Billboard Chart, lookin' to debut in this week's countdown. There's the wham-bam-glam sound of Poison, with "NOTHIN' BUT A GOOD TIME." And there's England's Def Leppard, roarin' again with their latest, "POUR SOME SUGAR ON ME." Are radio airplay and sales sweet enough to send them into the survey? We'll find out as we count down the week's biggest hits, from #40 to #1 on American Top 40.

4. CHEAP TRICKS DONE HERE (:22)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. The band who asked us to "Surrender" to the "Voices" of the "Dream Police", look countdown bound again. The popular pop rockers of the late 70's and early 80's, Cheap Trick, could have their first Top 40 hit in eight years with "THE FLAME." It's litin' a fire on the Official Billboard Chart, and Cheap Trick could be hot stuff to debut this week on American Top 40.
