1) RICK'S #1 TRICK (:20)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Back in March, English newcomer Rick Astley had his first hit, 'NEVER GONNA GIVE YOU UP'. And it didn't let up 'till it hit #1. So far he's reached #2 on the Official Billboard survey with his second hit, "TOGETHER FOREVER". Can Rick pull the #1 trick again? We'll find out, countin' down the nation's favorite forty songs on American Top 40.

2) ROCKERS AND RAPPERS (:24)

This is Casey Kasem. A slew of songs scaling the Official Billboard Chart could debut in this week's countdown. There are rockers Van Halen, with "BLACK AND BLUE". Rappers D.J. 4) ROCKIN' ROBERT (:20)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. He was the singer who with Led Zeppelin scored ten Top Ten albums, six of 'em went to #1. Then he got sweet and sassy on us in the Honeydrippers. And now his latest solo hit, "TALL COOL ONE", is climbing the countdown. Robert Plant's plowing up the Official Billboard Chart, makin' his moves on American Top 40.
