DARYL HALL & JOHN OATES

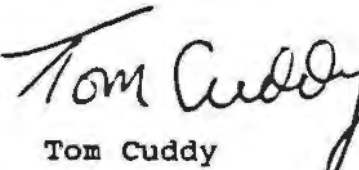
This is the first time in AT40's history, we've had rock stars host the show. But since this month we're celebrating the show's 18th Anniversary, we wanted to do something special!
