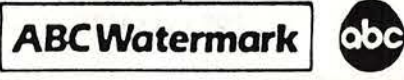

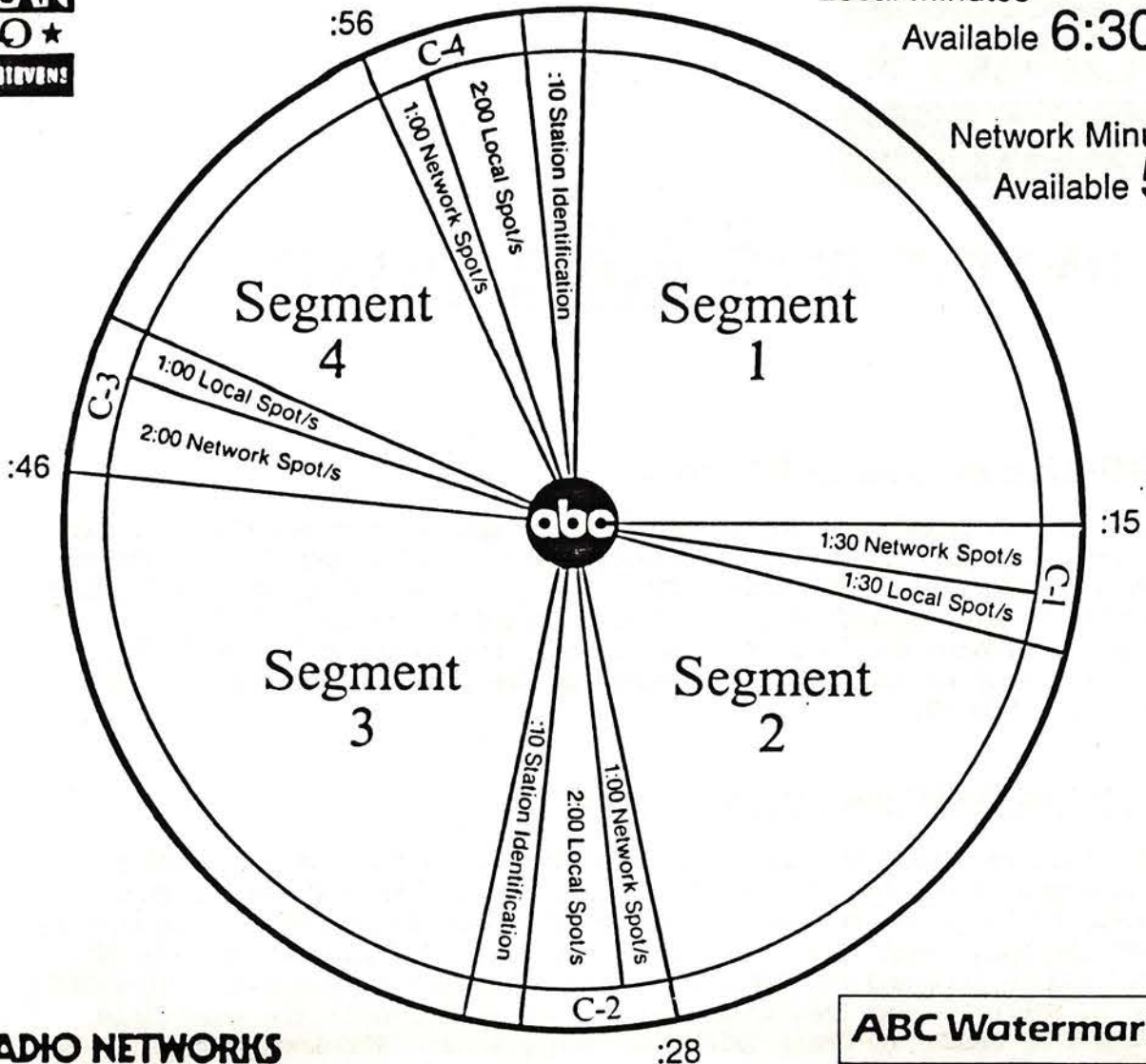

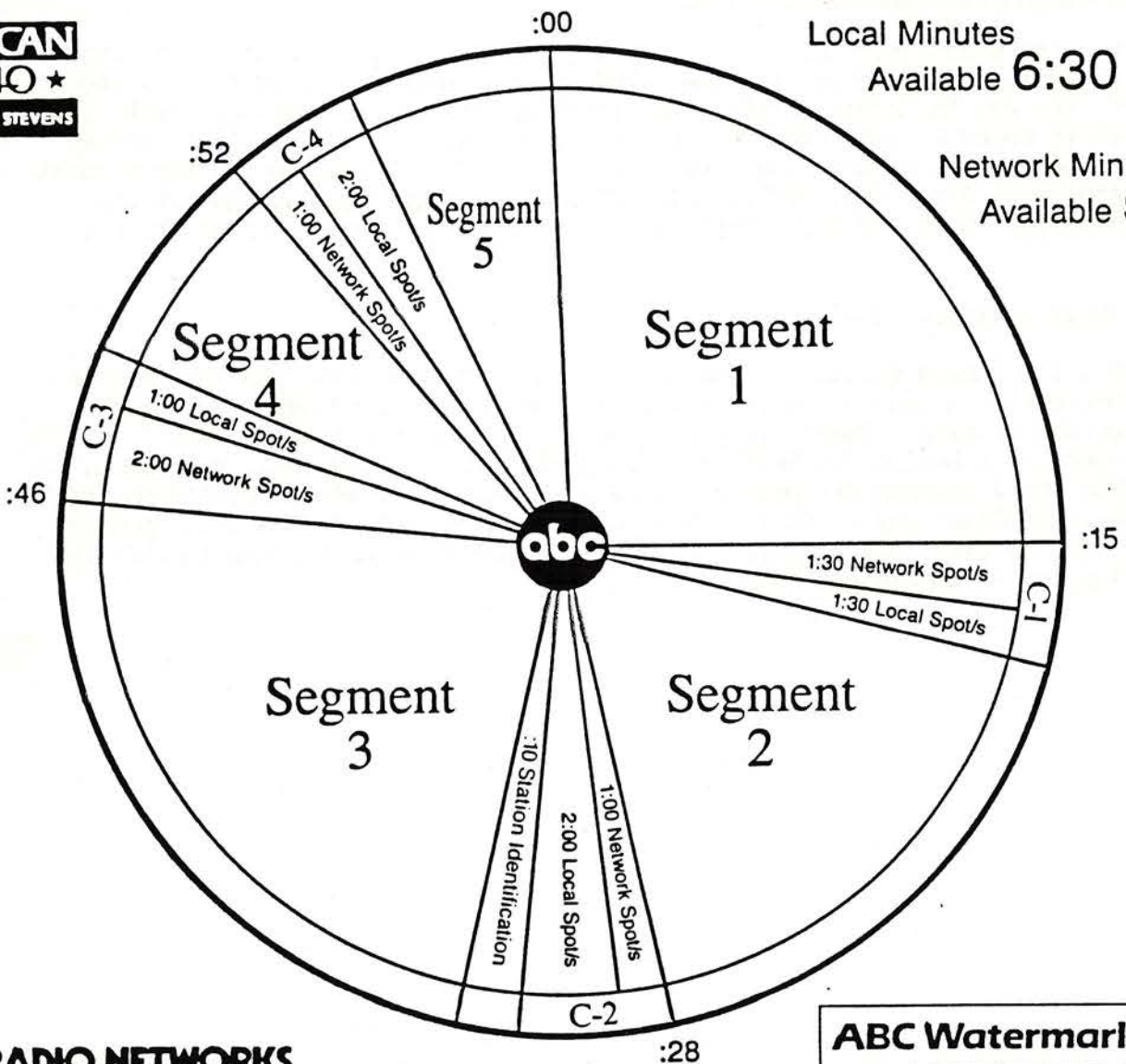

1. ROLLING HANDS TO HIT HEAVEN (:25)

Hi, this is Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. On last week's Billboard Chart, English soul man Steve Winwood was on a roll, spending his third week on top singing "ROLL WITH IT". But just down below, the new British group, Breathe gasped again at #2 with "HANDS TO HEAVEN". And they'd like to Breathe deeply at #1. Who'll come out on top this week? The answers will be revealed as we countdown the pick of pop appeal -- on American Top 40.

2. COUNTDOWN CONTENDERS? "D'SHADOE KNOWS (:31)

Hi, this is Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40, looking at last week's Billboard Chart, for this week's hopefuls in the debut derby. Crowded House may move in with their latest, "BETTER BE HOME SOON". Bruce Hornsby and the Range could peer into our pop survey with "LOOK OUT ANY WINDOW". D.J. Jazzy Jeff and the Fresh Prince might scare up a hit with "NIGHTMARE ON MY STREET". 3. POWER BURNS AND GARDENING TIPS (:27)

Hi, I'm Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. One year ago, this L.A. band of rude, rowdy rockers released their first album, and fought every inch of the way for radio airplay and video exposure, while word-of-mouth, and their concerts sent them on a Billboard rampage.
