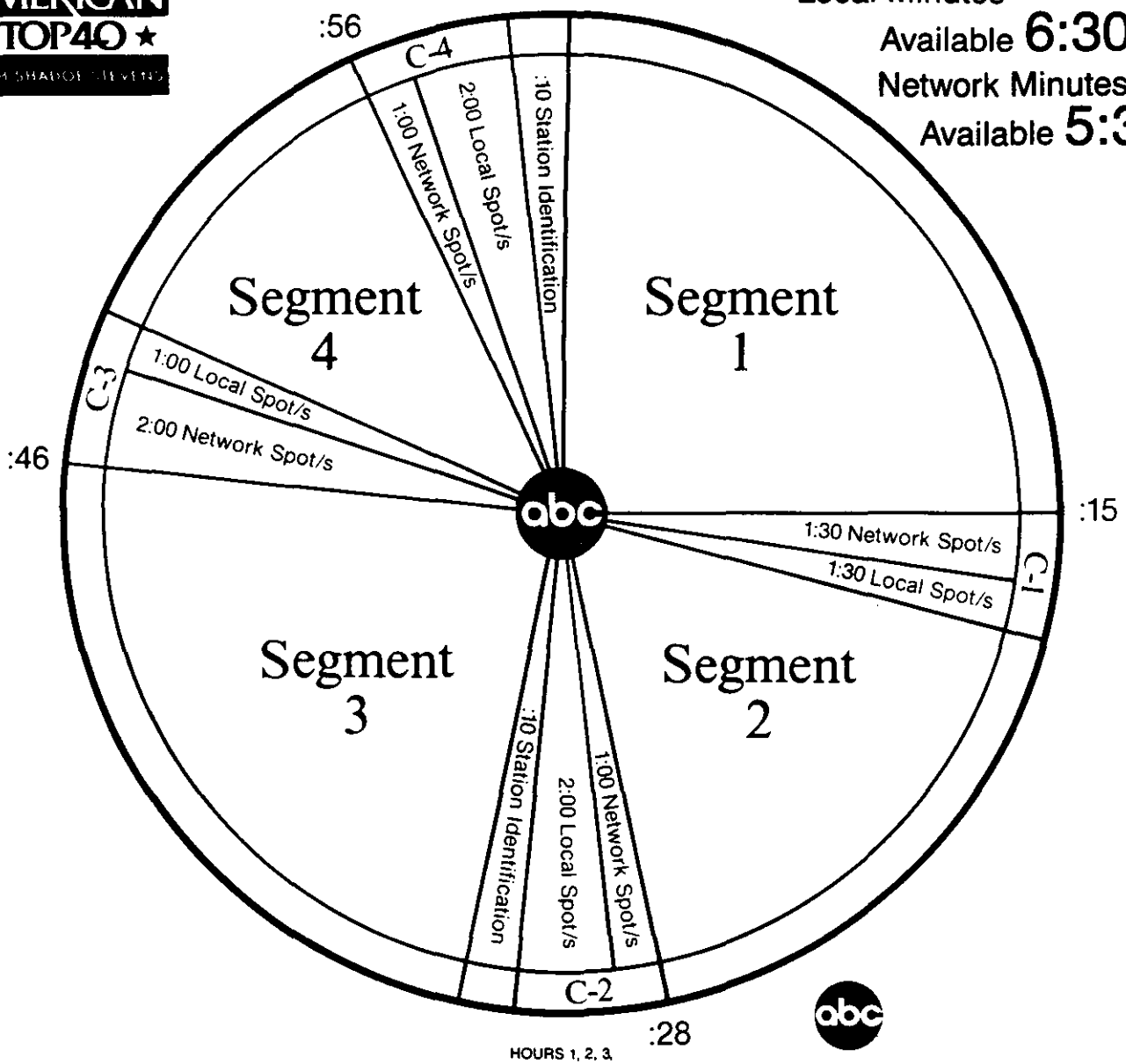

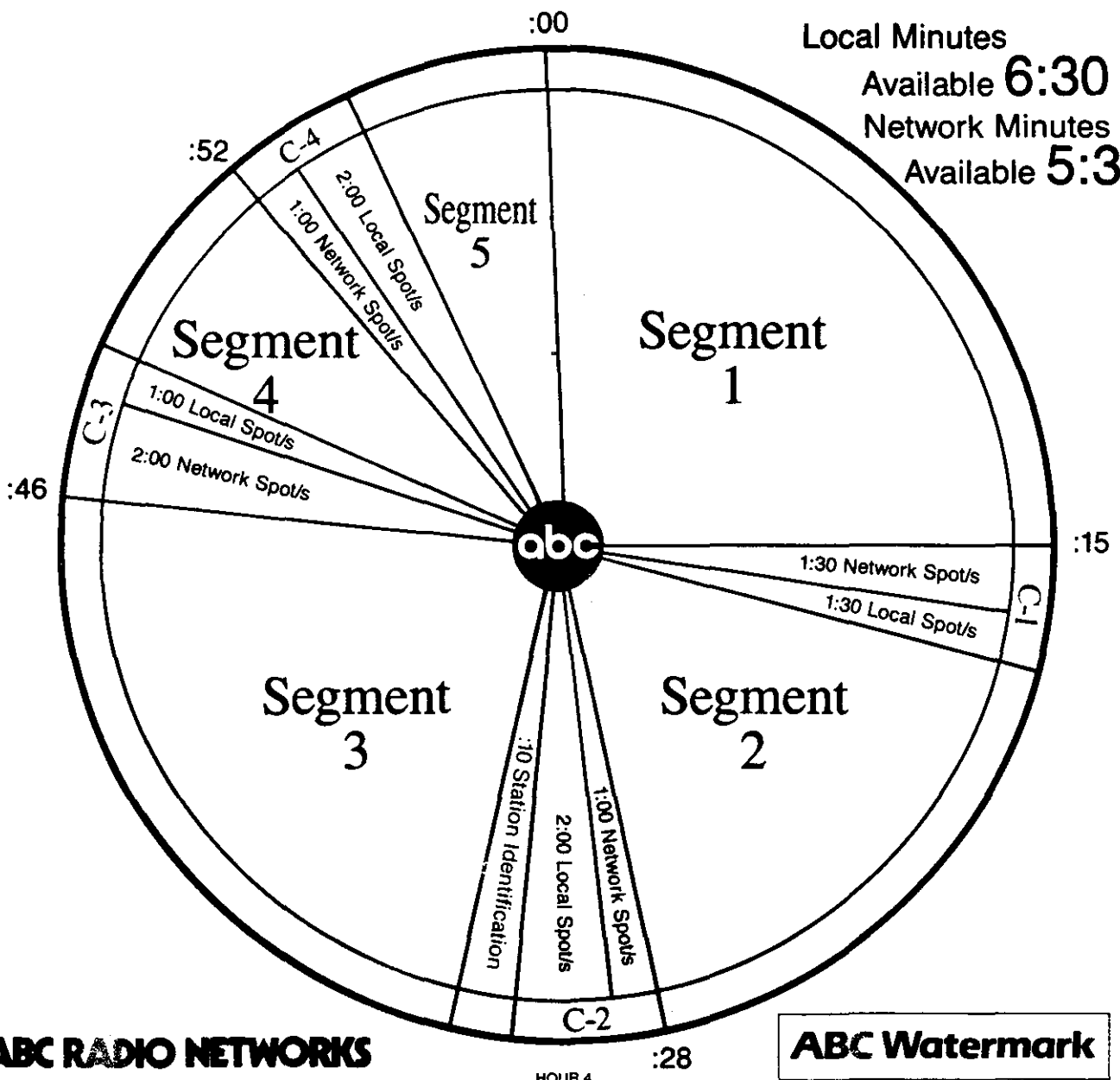

1. BUSTIN' OUT :21

Hi there, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. Phil Collins makes his screen debut as a leading man in a new movie called, "Buster". It hasn't even been released nationwide, but the soundtrack is already 'bustin' out the hits. Phil took "GROOVY KIND OF LOVE" to #1 on the Billboard Chart -- and now here comes the follow-up. It's called "TWO HEARTS". Phil Collins is looking countdown-bound again -- on American Top 40.

2. TAYLOR-MADE FOR SUCCESS :20

Hi, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. First, she dazzled us in the countdown Top Ten with Dance hits: "TELL IT TO MY HEART" and "PROVE YOUR LOVE".
