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

1. WINDY CITY WINNERS :22

Hey, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40...Last week, they scored their third Number One with the song "LOOK AWAY". And recently they also become the Top American Male Group on the Singles Chart in the Rock Era, taking over from the Four Seasons. They're the band originally from the windy city...the city of the Big Shoulders...that toddlin' town — Chicago. The group Chicago have topped the Billboard Chart again — on American Top 40.

2. GIVING US HER BEST ON THE CHARTS :21

Hi, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. The New Album by this soulful singer with the Jazzy style is already #2 on the Album Chart. And the first single, the title song "GIVING YOU THE BEST THAT I GOT", has climbed to #5 on the Pop Singles Chart. Hey, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. Two years ago, she hit the Top Ten with "TOUCH ME". This past year, she told us "NAUGHTY GIRLS NEED LOVE, TOO". And now, Britain's pin-up princess, Samantha Fox, is back on the Billboard Chart with more news. Sammy sings, "I WANNA HAVE SOME FUN" -- and she's ready to play in the countdown this week -- on American Top 40.
