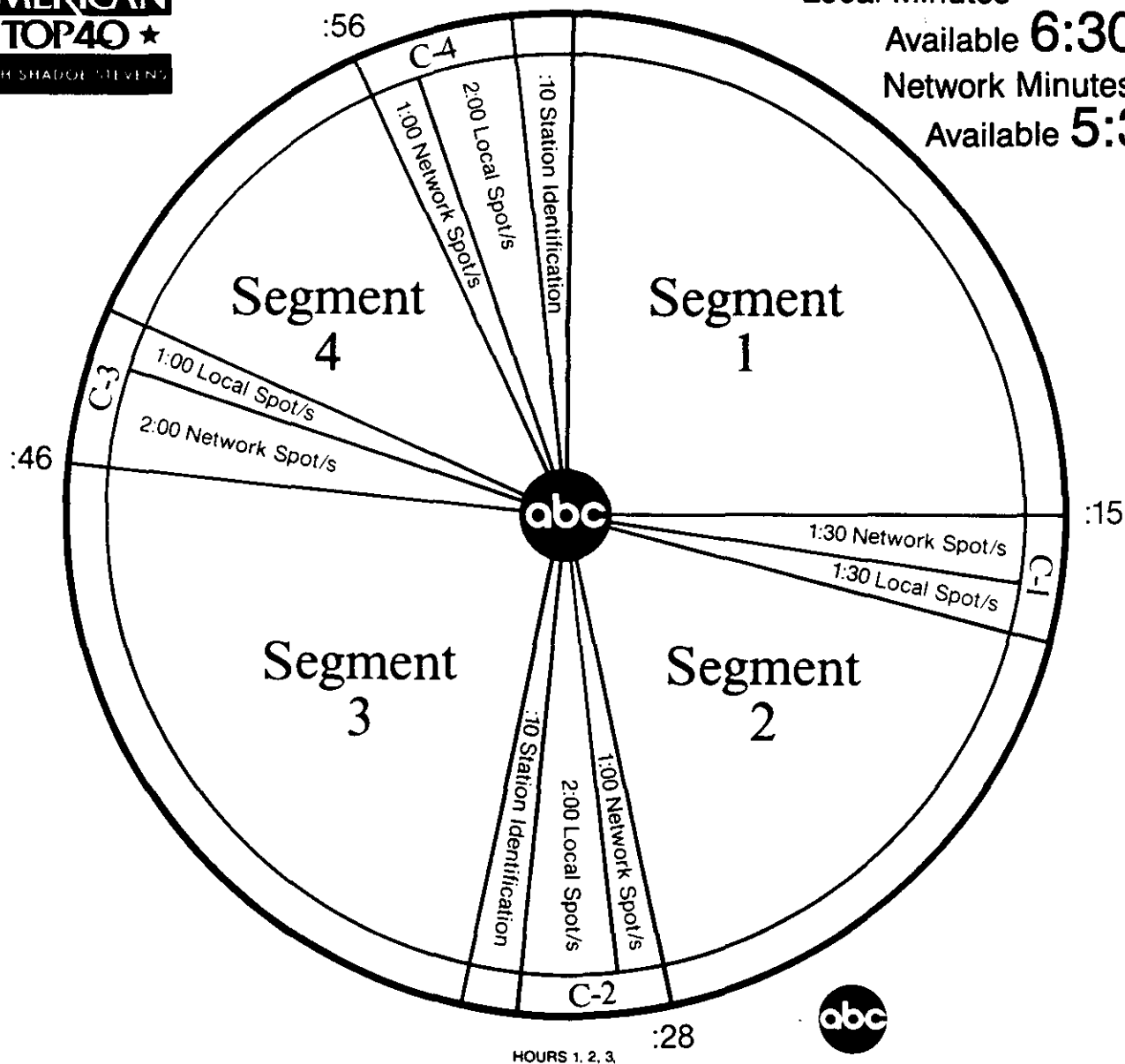

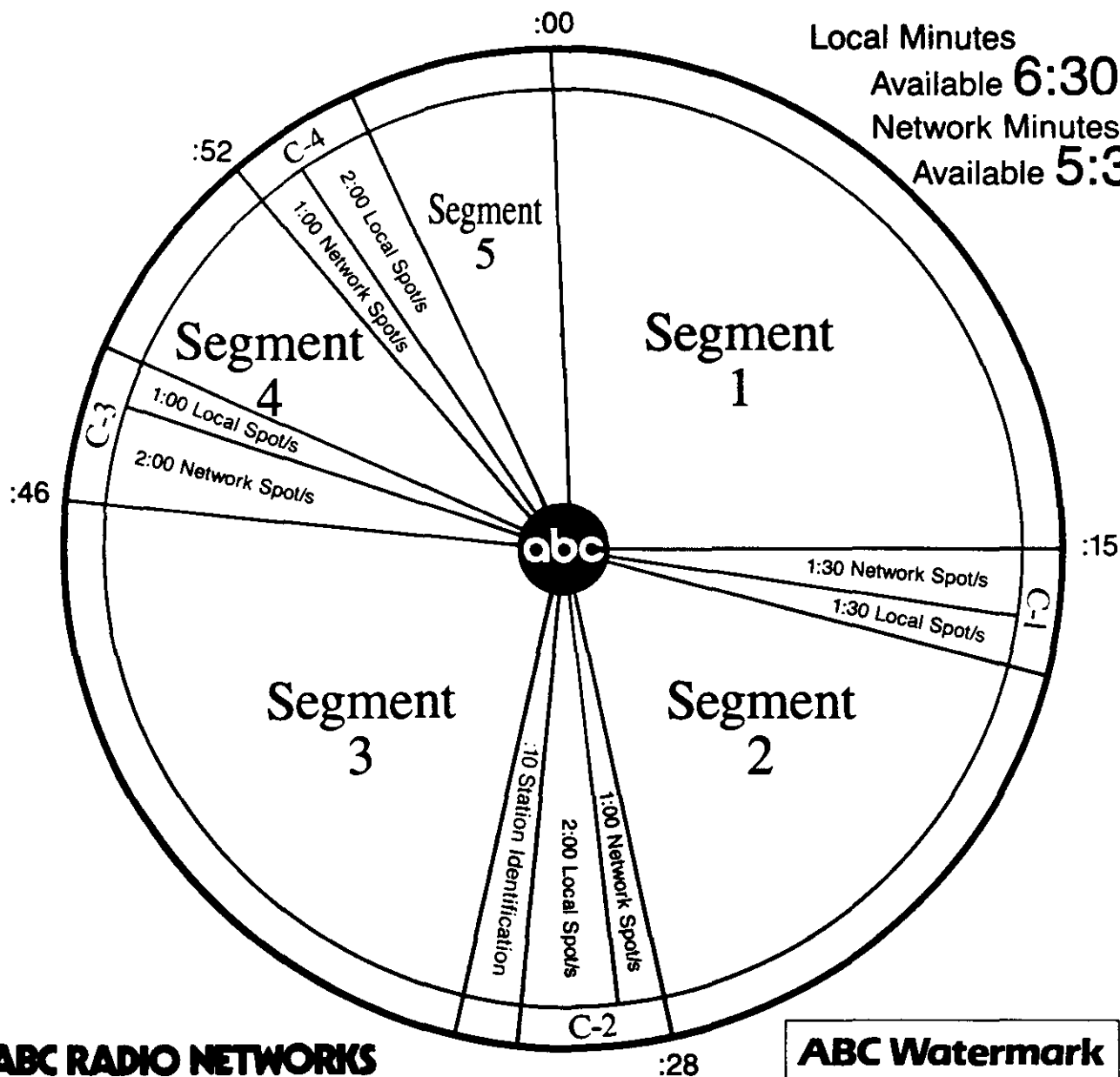

1. **POISON POWER** :23  
Hi, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. This 4 man Glam-Rock Band have blasted up the chart in the past with hits like "NOTHIN' BUT A GOOD TIME" and "FALLEN ANGEL". But now, Poison look poised to hit the top of the Official Billboard Survey. Their ballad -- "EVERY ROSE HAS IT'S THORN" -- climbed to #2 last week. Does their tender toxic tune have the power to put Poison at #1? D'Shadowe knows...on American Top 40.
2. **SHEENA. QUEEN OF THE CHART JUNGLE** :22
