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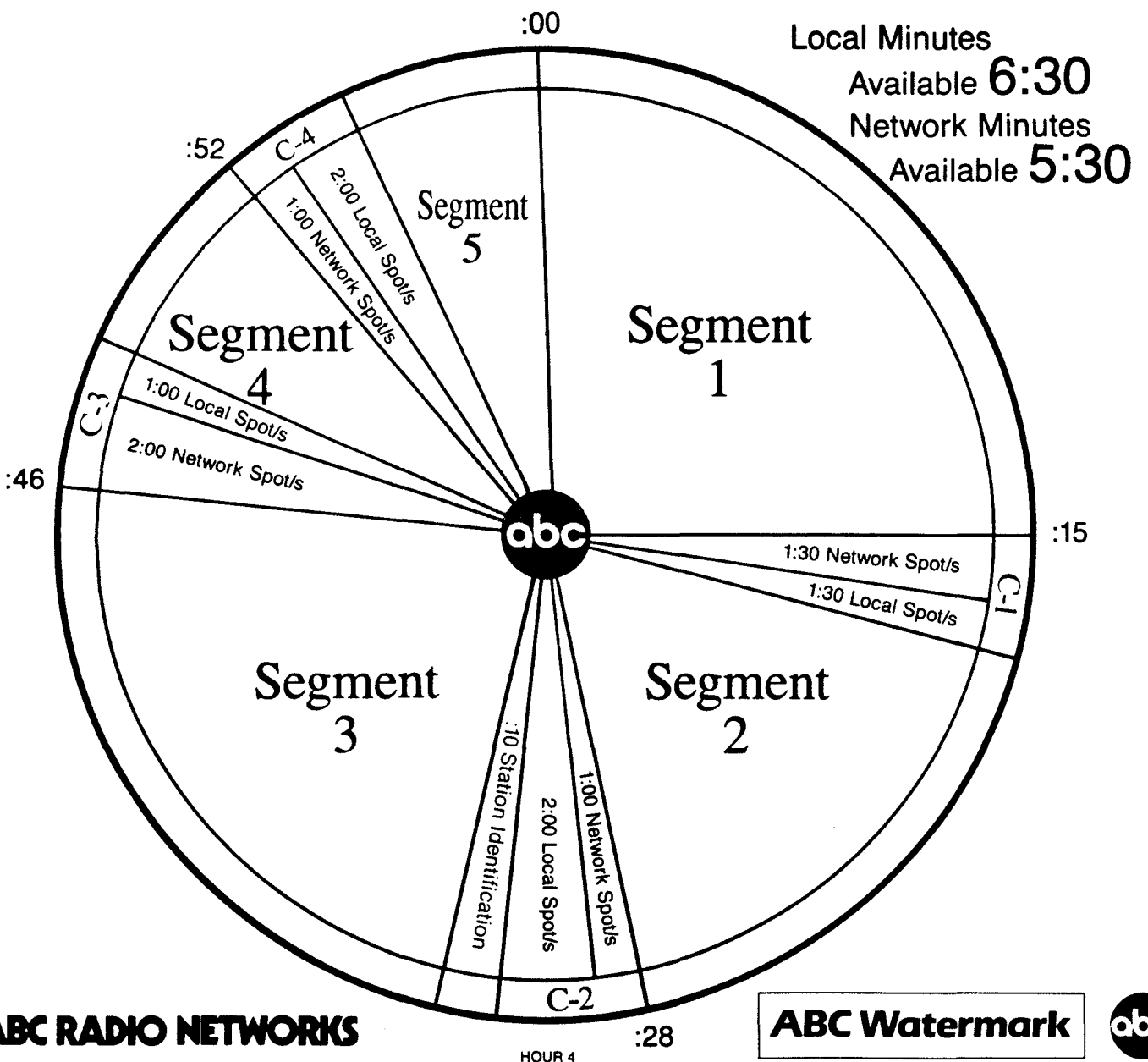
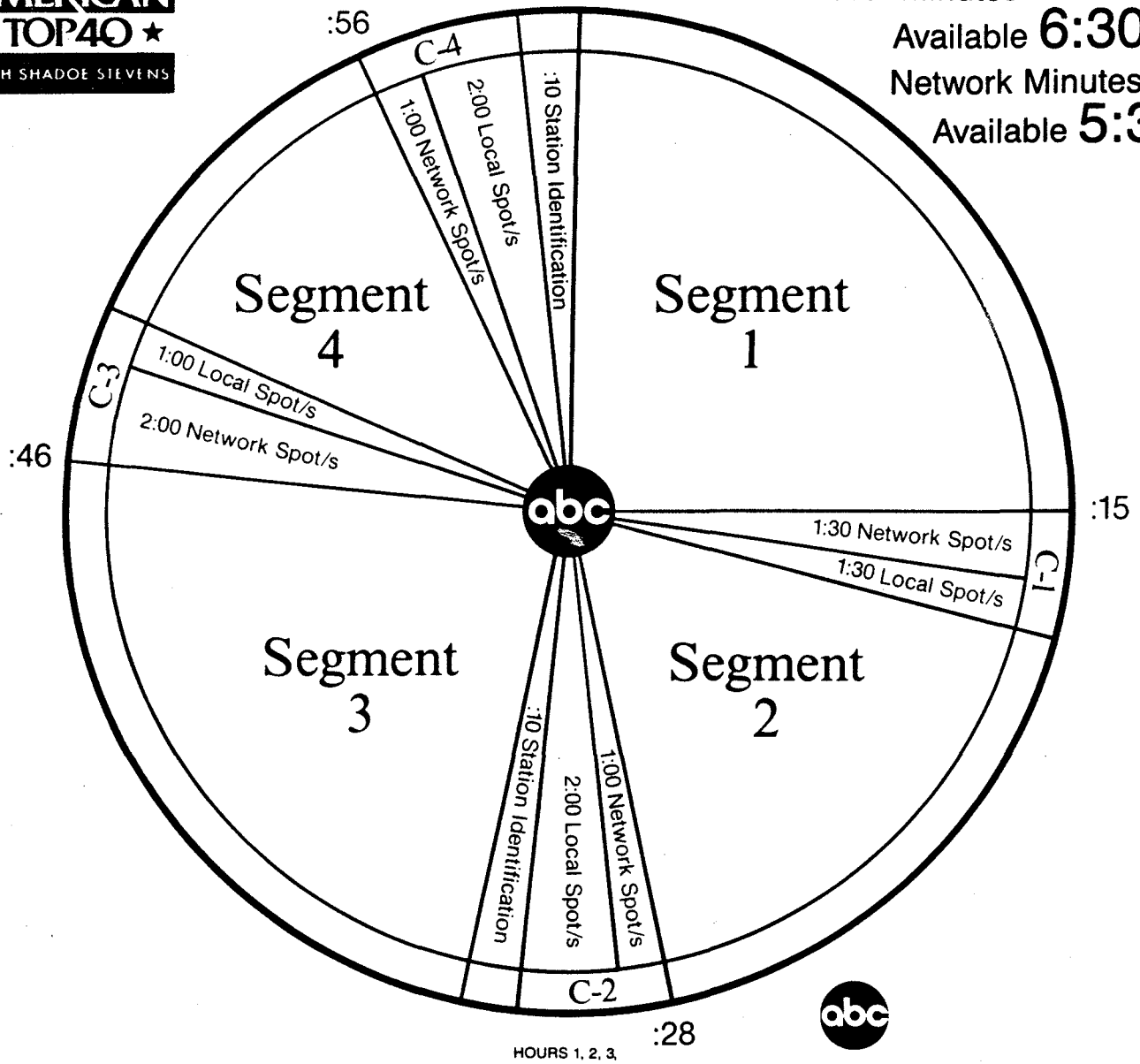

1. **A THORNY PREROGATIVE** :23  
Hey, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. Last week, Poison remained planted at #1 with their song "Every Rose Has It's Thorn." But Right below at #2, was Bobby Brown and "My Prerogative." Will the Glam-Slam rockers continue to bloom with their ballad on top, or will Bobby exercise his funky prerogative to hit #1? We'll find out this week on the only official countdown of Billboard Magazine's biggest hits... American Top 40.
2. **IRISH SOUL ANGEL** :23  
Hi, I'm Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. The first hit from their #1 album "Rattle & Hum," hit the top five, and now "Desire," is descending the official Billboard Chart. But, U2 on the way back with a new hummable hit rattling towards the countdown...a song inspired by the horn-powered Memphis soul of the 60's. It's "Angel of Harlem," spreading it's wings for U2 to debut...on American Top 40.
3. **RECORD BREAKING SMOOTHY** :23  
Hi there, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. Last week, he took his latest smash, "Smooth Criminal" into the top ten, and he set a new record for the most top ten hits in the 1980's. Michael Jackson's now had 17 top tens in this decade, and if he hits #1 with his song, he'll set another record. We've got the record-makers and the record-breakers, and we count down their hits each week...on American Top 40.
4. **PUT A LITTLE LOVE IN THE TOP TEN** :24  
Hi, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. He hit number one on the Billboard chart in the 1970's, singing "Let's Stay Together." She's hit number one in the 80's with her partner Dave Stewart, as Eurythmics, with "Sweet Dreams." For the past few weeks, Annie Lennox and Al Green have been moving up the countdown with their duet, "Put A Little Love In Your Heart," from the movie "Scrooged." Annie and Al could put 'a Little Love' in the top ten this week...on American Top 40.
