- 1. DON'T RUSH HER :20
  Hi, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. Her first three chart singles all made the top 10: "TELL IT TO MY HEART", "PROVE YOU LOVE", and, "I'LL ALWAYS LOVE YOU." Now, singing "DON'T RUSH ME", Taylor Dayne has pushed her way to #2. This week she could become the latest artist in the 80's to hit #1 with the fourth single from an album. We'll keep track of Taylor on the only official countdown of the Billboard hits on American Top 40.
- 2. THEY TARGET THE TOP :26
  Hi, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. Last week, Phil Collins scored his fifth solo #1 with "TWO HEARTS." Meanwhile, down below on the Biliboard Chart, Taylor Dayne climbed to #2 with "DON'T RUSH ME." And, at #3 it was Def Leppard with "ARMAGEDDON IT." Will Phil's heart beat sweet at #1 again? Will Taylor take it to the top? Or, will Def Leppard wreak havoc at #1? The answer awaits us this week as we count down the biggest hits in the U.S.A. on American Top 40.
- 3. HEAVY METAL PARADISE :24
  Hi out there, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. These sonic sensations took their debut album, "Appetite For Destruction", to #1. Then the first single, "SWEET CHILE O' MINE," hit the top of the pop chart, followed by "WELCOME TO THE JUNGLE," which ravaged the top ten, and now Guns N' Roses are blasting up the Billboard chart again with a heavy metal vision praising "PARADISE CITY." The Gunners are aiming to debut this week on American Top 40.
