- 1. <u>BOBBY'S BACK</u> :21
 Hey, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. His solo album, "Don't Be Cruel," has hit #1 on the album chart and given him two smash hits-the top ten title song and the recent #1, "MY PREROGATIVE." And now, Bobby Brown is back in the countdown with his latest hit, "RONI." Will he take this one to the top? We'll find out as we count down Billboard's biggest hits of the week on American Top 40.
- 2. CHART VETS
 Hey there, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. These chart veterans first blew out of the windy city they're named for 20 years ago. Their last hit, "LOOK AWAY," became their 31st Top 40 hit, then their 18th Top Ten, and then their third #1. Now Chicago are on their way back again, climbing the Official Billboard Chart with their follow-up, "YOU'RE NOT ALONE." Chicago, looking countdown-bound on American Top 40. American Top 40.
- 3. THE INCREDIBLIE HITS THAT WOULDN'T DIE :30
 Hey, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40, and if the Billboard chart was a movie, it might be a thriller-chiller called "The Incredible Hits that Wouldn't Die." Last year, we had an old hit by the British Band UB40: "RED RED WINE," that was revived by Radio Stations. It came back and went all the way to #1. And now, another record has risen out of the musical mists. It's the 1983 chart song, "WHEN I'M WITH YOU," by Sherrif. Last week, it reached #2. Will it hit the top? We'll find out as we count down to #1 on American Top 40.
- 4. RETURN OF THE ELECTRIC YOUTH :22
 Hi there, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. The teenager who became a star out of the blue, with five Top 40 hits from her first album, wrote all those songs herself, including the #1, "FOOLISH BEAT." And now, she's back on the Billboard chart with a hit from her second album, "Electric Youth." 18-year-old Debbie Gibson sings "LOST IN YOUR EYES," finding her way up the countdown on American Top 40.
