1. **WONDER WHITNEY MEETS MS. MADONNA FOR TITLE BOUT** :16
Hey, Shadoe Stevens on A-T 40. Last week, she took her latest hit, "LIKE A PRAYER," to the top...and Madonna tied Whitney Houston as the woman with the most #1's in the 80's. They've each had seven #1's in this decade. Just another page in Billboard Chart history, written on American Top 40.

2. **HIT HYSTERIA** :26
Hi, Shadoe Stevens on A-T 40. This British Heavy Metal band has forged the biggest-selling album, ever, for a group...their album "Hysteria." And it's filled with hit hysteria...it's made them only the third act to get seven chart singles from one album. Their latest, "ROCKET," blasted to #13 last week. Will Def Leppard roar in the top ten once again on the Billboard Chart? Ahhh, D'Shadoe knows...on American Top 40.

3. **SOUL QUEEN AND 70'S POP KING** :20
