

Their latest smash-ola, "I'll Be There For You," was there at #2 last week on the Official Billboard Chart. Bon Jovi are looking for another #1. Will they take over the top? Will Madonna maintain #1 Glory? Ahhh...D'Shadoe knows...on American Top 40.
- 2. BIG DADDY DEBUT :26
  Hi, Shadoe Stevens on A-T 40. He haunted us with heartland stories on his album "Scarecrow." He told tales of life's "Lonesome Jubilee." Now, John Cougar Mellencamp is coming back with a new album whose title comes from his little girl's nickname for her papa..."Big Daddy."
