1. Wilson Phillips' new album "Shadows and Light" has only been out for a couple of weeks and already it's way up near the top of the chart. The girls have known each other since they were-- well, just how young were they when they first met? Chynna's mom, Knots Landing star Michelle Phillips remembers, and told us what kind of kids they were:

MICHELLE PHILLIPS ACTUALITY: (:34) "Oh, they were the very, very best of friends. Uh, it was really Chynna and Carnie who were together from the time they were born. They're the same age. Within two months. I think Carnie is two months older. But I remember the first time we went to the park together. And Marilyn brought Carnie and I brought Chynna. And it seems from that very day onward, when, we'd get the girls together all the time. They can't even remember when they met, because they have known each other all of their lives. And then of course, Wendy came along. And she was always like, the little younger sister who's always tagging along. They didn't get into trouble, that's the strange thing. No. Uh, I don't remember them ever getting into any trouble at all. When Chynna was a little older, you know, she wrecked her car, she would stay out late, you know, but....I can't remember one incident where Chynna and Carnie ever got into trouble. I remember them singing together and hanging out together. They just loved each other from the very beginning."

2. Now this is pretty darn rare: Two pairs of brothers in one group. That's the story of this group, from Charlotte, North Carolina -- JODECI. They told us how they got together, and who they REALLY owe it all to:

JODECI ACTUALITY: (:52) "We were in two separate groups at the time in Charlotte North Carolina. And, we had this studio. And, we slept there and everything, you know. So, these girls in the group Unity, they were cousins. They was all related. So, they knew Devante and Dalvin. But we didn't. We always wanted to meet them, and they always wanted to meet us, because it was like, "yo, these brothers, they bad, man. Ya'll should meet up with 'em. Do something." So, we was like, "Where are they at?" And they would hear the same thing about us. So anyway, the girls brought Davante and Dalvin by, along with some more of Davante and Dalvin's friends. So, first thing, I was going with one of the girls. One of 'em was my girlfriend. And one of 'em was Davante's girlfriend. So when they walked in, I saw my girl and her cousins walk in. And I saw these guys, you know, I had never seen 'em before. First thing came to my mind was, "Hold up, hold up now. You gonna bring some guys into my studio? I don't know...What's up with that? You talking to one of 'em or something?" That's the first thing came to my mind. I never thought that they were, you know, into music. So, we almost got into a fight, I mean a real fight. So, Devante came into the studio. And, he knew we could sing. But I just never heard him play. So he got on the keyboards and he started playing. And Dalvin got on the drums and everything. And the first thing came in my mind was like, "Forget the fighting. We got something here." So you know, then he started playing something that me and Jo-Jo knew and we started singing along with it. And everything just blended so well. We was like -- we forgot about the girls."
