1. It's a LONG way from her third Top 40 hit, "KEEP ON WALKIN," back to her VERY FIRST TIME singing on stage in a school production of a Comic *OPERA*. But it was a really important moment for -- CE CE PENISTON:

CE CE PENISTON ACTUALITY: (:35) "It started out in 6th grade. When I had an audition for a music theater. The show was called "HMS Pinnafore." And, my teacher at the time -- her name was Miss Hamilton -- she was like, 'Well, we'll have this show. Why don't you come and try out.' I was like, 'Okay.' So I came and tried out. The night of the show came up. And I sang. And my mother, after I got through with the whole show, she came up to me. She said, 'Ce Ce, I didn't know you could sing like that. You never sing like that at home. Where'd this come from?' I was kinda like - you know a little kid, they kinda shrug their shoulders. You're like, 'I don't know.' But I just knew from that point on that being on stage was something very natural for me and something I wanted to do for, you know, a long time. Maybe the rest of my life."
