

1. The latest hit from George Michael is "TOO FUNKY," and we've mentioned that George no longer appears in his music videos, except for brief cameos. George told us how he really feels about the whole video phenomenon:

GEORGE MICHAEL ACTUALITY: (:28) "I think one of the beauties of writing is that the listeners interpretation can be completely off, but it really means something to them. More and more, as video advances, people's way of listening to the music becomes far less imaginative. I think it's done a disservice because the best music is always open to interpretation, and open to complete emotion. You shouldn't have a storyboard running through your mind when you listen to it. It should mean something different to each person."

2. A few weeks ago, HAL DAVIS, the producer and co-writer of the original Jackson 5 #1 version of "I'LL BE THERE" from 1970 -- told us HOW that song happened, and Hal said that in the writing and recording process, He got so excited about the song that he phoned Motown chairman Berry Gordy at about Five O'Clock in the morning! But the story goes on, because Berry Gordy got even with his OWN phone call. And Hal Davis fills in the blanks:
