



- 1. Genesis' current it is "JESUS HE KNOWS ME" -- and Phil Collins told us the band was inspired by Tel-Evangelists -- and one of 'em in particular:
- PHIL COLLINS OF GENESIS ACTUALITY: (:35) "The one that sticks with me the most is a guy called Ernest Anglsey, who is not disreputable, and he seemed to be believed and I could watch an hour of him and not get bored, I mean he's great fun. But really, the kind of guys we're talkin' about are the people, that, and they know who they are, you know, and we all know who they are and modesty prevents me from mentioning their names! But, they do, they are either in prison, or they're going to prison, for not practicing what they preach, basically. And the insincerity of the whole thing and the hypocrisy. And they're there every Sunday, 24 hours a day, for that particular day, all across the channels, there's hundreds of them."
- 2. This song's been a hit twice -- First in the 1970s for ROSE ROYCE. And now for THE COVER GIRLS... "WISHING ON A STAR." The lead singer is Cover Girl MICHELLE VALENTINE. We asked Michelle if she knew the original, and what she thought when her group's producers brought it to them:
- MICHELLE VALENTINE OF THE COVER GIRLS: (:25) "We were all familiar with it, and we all really loved it, just like most of America. We wanted to do it right, you know, because it's a lot of, it's a big favorite of many, and we didn't want ruin it. So we went into the studio and fortunately, we were able to do a good job on it, and the way we've done it with our own added touches, has made people who didn't know it already, enjoy it as well, so I'm very happy with the success of it."
- Let's talk about the man behind the sound -- the man responsible for the incredibly successful sound of the MIAMI SOUND MACHINE... He's also responsible for solo hits for his wife, GLORIA ESTEFAN. Emilio Estefan may be a behind-the-scenes guy, but don't underestimate his importance -- he's an essential part of Gloria's music. And now he's co-produced the debut album by JON SECADA, including Jon's first hit. "JUST ANOTHER DAY." We recently sat down with Jon and he told us HOW he hooked up with his producer:
- JON SECADA ACTUALITY: (:35) "I hooked with Emilio through the boys in the band, the bass player, the keyboard player, I went to school with them. Emilio was looking for new people for Miami Sound Machine, new players, and he asked these guys to join the band. When that happened, about a year or so after they joining the Miami Sound Machine, Emilio heard my demo tape through George Goffas the bass player. And that kind of started the whole thing, he just called me up one day out of the blue, I mean the storybook, fairytale type of thing. He said, 'I like your voice, I like your music, do you need a manager?' And I said heck yeah!"
