1. Peter Cetera has been solo for a few years now, but he spent almost 20 years as bass player and lead singer for the 70's supergroup CHICAGO. We asked Peter how he looks back on those good old days:

PETER CETERA ACTUALITY: (:25) "We had a lot of fun, I mean, we used to always go in and talk to company's rock 'n roll guys and we'd come into town and play people in softball games and beat 'em, and we'd go bowling and go out and laugh and joke. And some of the stage memories were great, I think we were the first one ever sell out Madison Square Garden five nights in a row and you know, there was a lot of having the number one song in the world, you know, just a lot of fun.

2. Technotronic is the name of that Belgian group that conjures up images like the steady pulse of androids, linked with computers, making R2-D2 sounds. So, when we sat down with Jo Bogart -- the mastermind behind Technotronic -- we asked about the name... Where did he get it... and, just what does it mean?

JO BOGART ACTUALITY: (:28) "Well, when I was thinking about a name, what I knew that I wanted was something with 'tronic'. It always intrigued me. And then, while I was doing these tracks, I told, what can you say, what kind of style is this? I was wondering myself about it, you know. And, in house, the most intriguing kind of music was 'techno' from Detroit. And so I combined these together. And that was Technotronic!"
