1. We recently spoke with Peter Cetera and asked him about what's probably the most traumatic adult experience you can have - DIVORCE. It affects your whole life -tears it apart. I didn't write every song on the album because I couldn't at this point, you know, but this and that were relevant to the situation... and so, that's the album."

EN VOGUE ACTUALITY: (:32) "Ok, for starters, Cindy and I have a friend, a mutual friend, who told us about the auditions, for a project called 'The FM Square Album', which stands for Foster-McElroy. Dawn and Maxine met at a beauty salon, maybe two years before... all of us had met a long time ago... yeah, a long time like years, way before the audition, therefore, we never knew that we'd even see each other again. Then, we all showed up for the audition in Richmond, California at the same time. Initially, they wanted three girls, but they liked the blend, and the personality blend so well, they decided to keep four. That's it, huh!"
