



- 1. This next group once held a contest for high schools in the San Francisco Bay Area and First Prize was a concert from these two guys. All the students had to do was send in the most 3 by 5 postcards to the station sponsoring the contest. High won with about a million and a half entries. But, what really stunned these guys was the total amount of entries from all of the high schools: seven and a half MILLION entries! Go West told us about it:
- GO WEST ACTUALITY: BOB: (:24) "Well, I'm not exactly sure it was seven and a half million... it was seven an a half million cards... I think the kids were like writing them out as fast as they could, each kid writing out like a hundred, two hundred cards or something like that. But, we went to have a look at the cards, when they took them all away to the refuse place... Well, we didn't believe it basically. We thought it was the record company, trying to pump up our ego... this mountain of cards... we had our picture taken"
- 2. "SOMETIMES LOVE JUST AIN'T ENOUGH" is the biggest hit ever for Patty Smyth. Patty co-wrote it with Glen Burtnick and she told us it's a personal song, one that she could really relate to:
- PATTY SMYTH ACTUALITY: (:37) "I think a lot of things come disguised as love, and it's not love... a need for someone, loneliness, obsession, lust, passion of the moment, whatever... you know, and that's why the line is 'it's sad when you know it's your heart you can't trust', because when you're there and you're going well, is this love? Was that love? So, it's kind of like that. I mean, I think the point of that song was saying 'I'm not blaming you' and 'I'm not taking the blame either, but that I'm sad about it and, you know, I want to know if you think about it too, or something. But, you know, I mean it was almost like emancipation. It's like, I didn't feel I had to point the finger at anyone anymore... I just know that, that's just the way it is sometimes."
- 3. Boyz II Men have remade a song that goes way back to the days of doo-wop rock and roll. And the man who wrote and sang the original is Fred Parris. He was the lead singer of The Five Satins, the name of the Group that made "IN THE STILL OF THE NIGHT" a rock classic back in 1956. We tracked him down in Connecticut and he told us this short little story of how he came up with the song, while he was in the Army:
- FRED PARRIS ACTUALITY: (:17) "I was stationed right outside of Philadelphia, near the international airport, I wrote it on guard duty, at about 3 o'clock, and I was thinkin' about my girlfriend, and I knew I had to write a song for a session. And that's the song that came out! No secret, that's exactly what happened!"


