

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- 1. And now, straight from the pages of Vogue and Glamour with their latest hit, "GIVE IT UP, TURN IT LOOSE," here are the fashionable and fine, En Vogue. When they first came out a couple of years ago, it seemed like they had an image of dressing alike, no matter what the outfits. But, not anymore! Listen:
- EN VOGUE ACTUALITY; (:40) "We all look alike, but in different ways. We all pick our own stuff, we usually go into stores. That's been the easiest, actually, so far. It has, because it's an individual thing, but we've learned too, that we all have the same tastes. The things that we've worn, I think we'd all wear. Teri's starting to change the most because she's been the most conservative, and now, she's like the wildest! She'll come back with red, hot, see-thru shirt... but, she'll still be dressed from here... all the way to her toes. But it's always something real tight, but before she used to wear baggy clothes, dressed all teh way up to here! I did not wear baggy clothes! You still, but... now, I do feel better on stage, in something that I can feel, close to me, and I feel like I move better."
- 2. "SOMETIMES LOVE JUST AIN'T ENOUGH" has been a big hit for Patty Smyth, along with her good friend, Don Henley. Patty's been singing with Don since the '80s -- and she told us how Don finally got around to returning the favor:
- PATTY SMYTH ACTUALITY: (:33) "It is kind of a family tradition for us now, I sang on "INTO THE INNOCENCE" and I wrote the song like five years ago, and played it for him, and it really moved him, you know, 'cause I know that he dug what I was saying. And it's funny, you know, you don't really have that many peers or friends who you have that kind of communication with, and it moved him, and I said well, there's a really beautiful harmony part, you know. Do you want to sing it with me? And he goes like, yeah! And I didn't even know that he would sing so much of it 'cause it started out just him singing the choruses. But then we just traded off lines and it evolved."
- 3. The current hit from Boyz II Men, "IN THE STILL OF THE NIGHT", has always had a special kind of a magic, so, imagine the surprise when we found out where the Five Satins recorded the original back in 1956. The man who wrote and sang lead on that original version is Fred Parris, and he told us all about it:
- FRED PARRIS ACTUALITY: (:18) "St. Bernadette's, it's a Catholic Church in New-Haven, Connecticutt, right near the East Haven line, pretty big church, we did it in the basement. It was a stage, and we used very little equipment. We had, I think it was two track tape recorder, but it reproduced the sound that we needed to do what we had to do!
