1. Sting's current hit, "IF I EVER LOSE MY FAITH IN YOU." is from his album 'Ten Summoner's Tales.' He didn't do the album in a recording studio -- and he explains why:

STING - ACTUALITY: (:27) "I really don't like studios very much. I find them, sort of like, prison-like environments. Where you don't see the air -- or breathe the air, or see sunlight for months on end. So I decided that I'd make a record at home. You know, with the kids around. So I moved everybody out of the dining room. (Laughs) And moved this equipment in. And the kitchen was next door, so we had the nice smell of food going most of the day. And we could, you know, walk around in the garden, open the windows... And just live a real life, instead of a fake environment that the studio gives you."
