1. You could call this next man "The Rainforest Rock Star." He's done more to protect and preserve Rainforests than anyone else in music. If you've wondered if there's been any progress, Sting has some positive news to report:

STING ACTUALITY: (:41) "We had a very big success in that what we've been trying to do for almost five years was denotate an area of the Pacific jungle as Indian land. We got the Brazilian government to recognize it constitutionally as Indian. This is a huge area, the size of Switzerland. We then used the money we collected to put beacons around the perimeter which are linked to a satellite which monitors the perimeter, so anytime there's an encursion of a burning, the satellite can read it and then tell the Indians who police the area themselves. Having done that, we want to carry on doing it because we can do it again, but we need money.

2. Jon Secada told us what it means to him to be 'a star':

JON SECADA ACTUALITY: (:36) "Star is a state of mind. I don't think that word exists, but to me, popularity means I'm proud and I'm flattered and it means that I've been blessed by the fact that my music is touching a lot of people and that I'm being appreciated for what I've done and what I'm doing and that word again, is attached to the fact that I'm an example, a role model to other people and through my example and my hard work to really, hopefully, be a positive influence to the world, to the community, my community and people that I visit and people that I touch with my music in my life."

Don't call it a comeback, I've been here for years, but you know, at the same time, if that means the people are gonna rally round you, I don't care really. I don't mind the idea of hitting the comeback trail. I like it, really. It's quite romantic. We do the Arsenio Hall show and we were brought up in the film Madonna was talking about. And people have stated, I notice how people in this town are talking, they say... hey you know, those guys are really cool, like did you see them on Arsenio? Yeah! People are talking about us, which they haven't been doing for five or six years and they're starting to say, hey, these guys are cool. Madonna has been so cool, she can only get less cool. We've been so un-cool, we can only get cooler!"

JANET JACKSON ACTUALITY: (:19) "I hang out with them, you can't see that there are, the kids in here, the dancers and we hang out together. Some of us have known each other for years and some of us are very very stupid acting, very silly, but we, we'll go to Disneyland or we'll go to the movies or just come to my house. Just hang out an have fun."
