1. The new one for Duran Duran is called "TOO MUCH INFORMATION." We asked member John Taylor where it came from, and we got a pretty interesting answer:

JOHN TAYLOR ACTUALITY: (:54) "A lot of the album was actually influenced by the Gulf War and the presentation of the Gulf War on television. And what was really sickening about it was that it was like The NBA Playoffs or the World Cup or the Olympics. It was presented very much as a commercial thing. CNN would be saying well, we're gonna be going direct back to Kuwait, we're gonna have more news of those missile strikes after this! The Real thing, you know, and you'd be off into a commercial break and it was a disgrace! And that was the basis of several songs on this record. And there were other things as well. We'd kind of fallen in and out of love with MTV, we had a bust on MTV. I mean the song is kind of critical of the media as a whole, but it's also saying, we're part of the media, you know, so it's kind of a paradox and it's confused, which we are too!"

2. This next singer had to wait for just the right time to turn on the TV to watch her favorite pop music show. Toni Braxton tells us what she had to go through to catch a little "Soul Train"

TONI BRAXTON ACTUALITY: (:39) "When my parent would leave, my mom and dad would leave, I'd turn on the television and watch! We didn't listen to secular music, my dad's a minister, so I always used to sneak and watch "Soul Train". Unfortunately, my house work and my chores didn't get done, so I got in trouble for that but, I would wait, 'til we saw the car go down the driveway, we'd go: "OK, they're gone!" And sometimes my parents didn't leave until like the show was getting ready to go off,

before my parents left, because the show came on Saturdays and every Saturday my mom would go grocery shopping, she and my dad, so they would go at a certain time, I guess around eleven in the morning and the show came on at eleven. So, sometimes we missed it because my parents didn't leave until twelve, ha ha ha!"

3. This next group likes to keep things in the family. And that's easy for JODECI -- Two sets of brothers: Dalvin and Devante Degrate and Jo-Jo and K-C Hailey. KC told us why he thinks the brother thing works so well:

KC/JODECI ACTUALITY: (:42) "It's a lot better than like just a friend group, 'cause all of us, we know each other, we're not afraid to tell each other like, oh man, you must not do that edit, that's not right man, you don't do that!" You know, we're not afraid to say that. Say for instance, some groups, you know they're friends, but they'd be like, "Oh, I don't want to tell him that, you know, he might not be my friend!" But, if we tell each other something, we don't care! You'll be my brother anyway. You know what I'm saying, so you know, it's really nice, working as brothers, it's not as bad as people think it is. And I mean we do have out arguments, our fall outs, our fights, but we know how to make up, we still tell each other, you know, I love you, 'cause everyday we see each other we give each other hugs... it's real nice."
