

1. Next are four guys who sing great together. And the guys in Shai said they really have fun.

<u>SHAI ACTUALITY:</u> (:27) "It's been working out, we're still learning, still learning studio, ha ha. We vibe off each other well. Never a dull moment with Shai! Even when we're supposed to be a dull moment, we have quick wit so at any given point in the day, at any minute, somebody can say something and just set off something inside of everybody. It's crazy"

2. She's got a hit of her own, but we've been hearing LISA KEITH's voice for years on other people's records. Lisa gave us some of her past credits:

LISA KEITH ACTUALITY: (:35) "Songs that I've done backround vocals are "Control" for Janet Jackson, "Human" by the Human League, Herb Alpert "Keep Your Eye On Me" and "Diamonds". "Diamonds" actually I did co-lead with John Jackson on that. The Luther and Janet duet, "Best Things In Life Are Free", "Rhythm Nation" by Janet Jackson and Karen White, "The Way I Feel About You," and actually I sing some background for Karen White also on her tour, which was kind of fun. And then some lead vocals, my very first lead was "Making Love In the Rain" by Herb Alpert, so that was really exciting. And then, as I said, "Diamonds" was also co-lead with Janet."

3. "Two Steps Behind" is one of the biggest hits ever for DEF LEPPARD. It was written by the band's lead singer JOE ELLIOT, and he told us the whole story of "TWO STEPS BEHIND."

JOE ELLIOT ACTUALITY: (1:22) "We were recording the 'Adrenalize' album and one of the weekends I begged Pete Woodruff, the assistant engineer on the 'Adrenalize' album, to stay in Dublin and record this song that I had. It was the kind of song that we got enough songs like that for the 'Adrenalize' album, but I wanted to get it out of my head and down onto tape and when we were thinking of doing some B sides for the singles that we were hoping to release off the 'Adrenalize' album, Joe suggested that we do "Two Steps Behind" accoustically, so we just got three accoustic guitars, sat in a room and just banged it out, in two or three hours. It was released in I guess, May or June of '92 in England as a fourth track on a single release and I think it was "Make It Like A Man", it was like a D side for what it's worth. And a year later, 'Last Action Hero' people come knocking on the door, saying we'd like you to do a song for us, what have you got that's not on the album? So we sent them basically all the songs that were gonna go on 'Retro-Active'. They chose "Two Steps Behind", 'cause they thought it was obviously the kind of song they were looking for. And it went on the movie soundtrack, it was always going to be going on our album as well, and then in June of this year, when we were doing the finishing touches to the album, we decided to dig out the electric version and it's kind of a bit of a strange story but it's the truth!"


4. Always amusing to talk to Mr. Big. We've got BILLY SHEEHAN and PAT TORPEY and they told us about the group 'Motto':

BILLY SHEEHAN/PAT TORPEY of MR. BIG ACTUALITY: (:44) "Well lately we've been saying if you think you stink, we actually stole that from someone... Sebastian from Skid Row. I think he understood the depth of philosophical impact that he had when he said it, but it's very true, that when think, you stink! If you're thinking, if you're out there calculating and figuring while you're playing, you probably are stinking. So we bring it to me and just kind of let the moment dictate what goes on, you kind of let your heart and your spirit take the lead, and follow it along as you play, you don't necessarily think or plan it out, 'cause we, I can see a musician up on stage, as soon as he starts thinking, he loses me. He's looking at his guitar neck and thinking and figuring, ooh, what cool thing should I... I'm gone! I'm outta there. See 'ya. He lost me."

4. Sometimes fame isn't all it's cracked up to be. This next singer told us about his reaction to it -- listen to what MEATLOAF has to say:

MEATLOAF ACTUALITY: (:43) "I like people coming to me and saying 'oh, I like your album or I like your work, or I loved your show' and I wanted to do this and I wanted to go tour and I wanted to make records, but I missed the side about being famous. I forgot that part and that's really not what Meal Loaf is about. Meatloaf's not about being famous. Meat Loaf is about the work and so, I was like a twist, it was... all of a sudden it scared me! I didn't want to do the record and so I kind of faked losing my voice and then I had a nervous breakdown and then I convinced myself, it was all psycosematic, and so once I went to the doctor, I was fine. I just went to a psychologist for about a year and he like beat me upside the head and said 'you're ok' now go away! And, so it was fine.
