K822-1: AIRDATE APRIL 3 & 4, 1982

SPANKY McFARLAND and NIGEL PICKERING, two of the original members of the popular mid-60'S group SPANKY & OUR GANG recall the influence of the Mamas & Papas in establishing their success with "Sunday Will Never Be The Same" and "I'd Like To Get To Know You."

ROBERT CULP, the star of the great 60'S TV show "I Spy" fondly remembers how he and co-star Bill Cosby brought a light touch to cloak and dagger adventure while breaking new ground in terms of race relations.

We'll take a special look at INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC of the early 60'S when a series of instrumental records burst onto the charts with a frequency that indicated a new phase in pop music. We'll also focus on the first week of <u>APRIL 1966</u>, sixteen years ago, when the first wave of discomania was sweeping the country!

K822-2: AIRDATE APRIL 10 & 11, 1982

SNUFF GARRETT was a Texas disc jockey with country star Waylon Jennings before he came to California where he was to become a top record industry executive and producer for Bobby Vee, Sonny & Cher, Gary Lewis & the Playboys, Johnny Burnette and Gene McDaniels, among many others.

ROSEMARY BUTLER currently sings back-up for such favorites as Jackson Browne, Nicolette Larson and Linda Ronstadt. But it was in the 60'S when Rosemary was the leader of an all-girl group called Birtha, that opened a concert for the Rolling Stones.

We'll take a special look at one of the most popular groups of the early 60'S, the DRIFTERS, which was actually a succession of different groups with different personnel. We'll also focus on the second week of APRIL 1968, fourteen years ago, when the hot fad in men's fashion was stick-on beards and moustaches!

K822-3: AIRDATE APRIL 17 & 18, 1982

Drummer <u>HAL BLAINE</u> backed up some of the biggest stars of the 60'S including Elvis, Phil Spector, the Beach Boys, the Mamas & Papas and the Monkees; Blaine recalls his fond memories of working with Brian Wilson and Glen Campbell.

LEON RUSSELL was a highly regarded session musician for the Byrds, Gary Lewis & the Playboys and Herb Alpert. In spite of the high pay and prestige of being a top session player, Russell longed to make his own records, which is what he is best known for today.

We'll take a special look at the city of <u>MEMPHIS</u>, the town that gave Elvis his start but also nurtured some of the best "soul music" talent of the 60'S, including the Mar-Keys, Booker T & the MG'S, Isaac Hayes and Sam & Dave. We'll also focus on the third week of <u>APRIL 1963</u>, nineteen years ago when teen idol Ricky Nelson was shedding his bachelorhood by applying for a marriage license!

K822-4: AIRDATE APRIL 24 & 25, 1982

JOE COCKER first hit the American charts with a Beatles tune, "With A Little Help From My Friends." However, it was his highly unorthodox stage style that gained him distinction. Cocker's career included a triumphant appearance at the ultimate rock festival, Woodstock.

LESTER SILL was instrumental in the career of the Monkees, whose #1 records included "Last Train To Clarksville," "I'm A Believer" and "Daydream Believer." Sill recalls how the group was created for television and that it would be an experience he would never forget.

We'll take a special look at DION DiMUCCI, whose impressive string of hit records included "Where or When," "Lonely Teenager," "Runaround Sue," "The Wanderer" and "Ruby Baby." DION recorded one of the biggest records of 1968, the poignant "Abraham, Martin and John." We'll also focus on the fourth week of <u>APRIL 1964</u>, eighteen years ago, when Sidney Poitier became the first black star to ever win the Oscar Award for "Best Actor!"

All this and as always with each show, a look at the <u>GREAT MOVIE THEMES</u> OF THE DECADE and our listeners talk about their favorite memories from the 60'S!
