

SOUNDTRACK OF THE 60's starts off with a look back at the Mersey beat of the mid-sixties and Gerry and the Packmakers, along with other members of the British second invasion. Though one of the biggest hits of the sixties was actually written in 1959. "Don't Let the Sun Catch You Crying" helped keep lead singer Gerry Marsden and his then fiance together. Written to help patch things up after an argument, evidently it worked since they were married shortly thereafter.


The classical influence has been with us for centuries. But to use Beethoven to make a Beatles hit? In 1969 by reversing Beethoven's Moonlight Sonata they came up with the haunting melody for "Because." The Beatles weren't the forerunners in this technique. In 1965 the Toys hit the charts with "A Lover's Concerto" based on Johann Sebastian Bach's "Five Finger Piano Exercise." Also in '65 Procol Harum borrowed from a Bach Cantana to create "A Whiter Shade of Pale."

Besides the classical influence on the pop artist the jazz artist came into his own on the charts as well. One of the notable efforts has to be Stan Getz teaming with Brazilian singer Astrud Gilberto to create the 1964 hit "The Girl From Ipanema." Others on the charts during this period included Dave Brubeck with "Take Five" the "In Crowd" by Ramsey Lewis and saxman Cannonball Adderly's unforgettable "Mercy, Mercy, Mercy."

Steve allen was one of the original late night funny men. His show featured the man on the street interview with Louis Nye doing the honors. This week we get a chance to talk to one of the most distinguished and dignified gentlemen of that early television era. Smock smock.

Movie memories this week take us back to the film with the best car chase scene ever. When Steve McQueen tightens up that seat belt on his Shelby Mustang you know that "Bullitt" is in for some high speed action. The scenes up and down the hills of San Francisco make the viewer wish for a seat belt even in the theater.

The top three songs for the third week in January of 1968 included the Beatles with "Hello Goodbye" at number three, "Chain of Fools" by Aretha Franklin at number two and number one, John Fred & His Playboy Band with "Judy In Disguise (With Glasses)."

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


